### Audit Findings:

### Lighting:

70 % of lighting fixtures are using outdated incandescent or fluorescent bulbs, which consume more energy than modern LED lights.

Suggested action: Replace outdated lighting fixtures with energy-efficient LED bulbs and install occupancy sensors to ensure lights are only on when needed.

Insulation: Insulation in some buildings is insufficient, leading to heat loss in the winter and increased cooling demands in the summer.

Suggested action: Improve insulation in buildings, particularly in areas with noticeable energy leakage.

### Suggested action:

Replace outdated appliances with Energy Star-rated models and encourage energy-conscious behavior among staff and students.

### **Energy Efficiency Recommendations:**

The college can then think about how to implement changes and save money. However, environmental sustainability is becoming an increasingly important issue for the nation; the role of higher educational institutions in relation to environmental sustainability is more prevalent

### Scope of the Audit:

The Green Audit of an institution is now of utmost importance for the institution's self-evaluation, as it represents the institution's contribution in reducing the current environmental issues. Since its foundation, the college has made attempts to maintain a clean atmosphere. As a result, the current green audit's goal is to identify, quantify, explain, and prioritize the environmental sustainability framework in accordance with the relevant laws, policies, and standards. The main objectives of carrying out Green Audit are:

- a) To identify the Geographical Location of the college
- b) To document the ambient environmental condition of weather, air, water and noise of the college
- d) To estimate the Energy requirements of the college
- e) To report the expenditure on green initiatives during the last five years
- f) To make energy saving management
- g) To make E-waste and solid waste management.

## Green audit report:

The core objective of the Green Audit committee is to develop and conserve green initiative in College Campus. Green audit create health consciousness and promote environmental awareness, values and ethics. It provides staff and students better understanding of Green impact on campus. If self-enquiry is a natural and necessary outgrowth of a quality education, it could also be stated that institutional self-



enquiry is a natural and necessary outgrowth of a quality educational institution. Thus it is imperative that the college evaluate its own contributions toward a sustainable future. As environmental sustainability is becoming an increasingly important issue for the nation, the role of higher educational institutions in relation to environmental sustainability is more prevalent.

Observations Noted: Some programs implemented by college towards green initiatives include;

Plastic free campus: The utilization Plastic bags are strictly avoided in the campus and campus is "no plastic zone". College motivates staff as well as students to utilize cotton or jute bags.

**Paperless office:** The office of our college is partially paperless. The different types of office information are delivered using email and SMS. College has created class wise whatsApp groups to deliver important instantly

**Tree Plantation:** The College has a system for green auditing of its facilities which is carried out by NSS. The college Student and staff have planted several tree samplings during various plantation programs organized by the college through NSS and all the trees are taken care of and maintained. NSS students from our College conducts tree plantation and public awareness program every year

Carbon free campus: The care of the campus surrounding is taken so that environment has maintained at low level of carbon emission and pollution. College avoids burning of waste materials which is collected from campus surrounding. The degradable and non degradable bio waste has been segregated and separated to recycle further.

Bio-degradable Waste: The shortlisted bio degradable waste which is collected from campus is decomposed to form compost which is further used in gardens as excellent manure.

Non degradable waste: The collected waste which is not degradable like unused plastic, glass bottles, electronic waste etc. is sent for recycling by selling it to scrapper. Students are motivated to design different objects like bags, foot wipes, show pieces etc. Students also motivated to donate unused but wearable cloths to poor peoples. The recycling of this non biodegradable waste is also helpful in soil quality conservation.

**Electricity saving:** Some older appliances and equipment, such as refrigerators and computers which are energy inefficient and producing more carbon to generate heat. These old instruments are replaced with Energy Star-rated models and encourage energy-conscious behavior among staff and students which are more energy efficient and power saving.

Saving Water in Campus: The College consumes a substantial amount of water for various purposes, including irrigation, sanitation, and cooling systems. Significant water leakage was detected in laboratory as well as toilet taps, leading to water wastage. The waste water and rain water has been recycled by rainwater harvesting which promotes both energy as well as water conservation. Rainwater harvesting improves quality and quantity of ground water.

A water audit is an on-site survey and assessment of water-using hardware, fixtures, equipment, landscaping, and management practices to determine the efficiency of water use and to develop recommendations for improving water-use efficiency.
